

SCHEDULING OF TREE DELIVERY

The following guidelines are designed to help Willits & Newcomb Inc. ensure you get your trees when you need them, where you need them:

- Willits & Newcomb Inc. gladly will arrange our delivery to fit your schedule. We do, however, request at least three-week's notice prior to desired plant date. This will allow ample time to schedule the digging and delivery.
- Growers must contact their County Agricultural Department notifying them that citrus trees are being delivered. Willits & Newcomb Inc. will provide the necessary moving permits.
- Trees are delivered in bins – 50 trees per bin. A forklift is required to unload and transfer them to equipment that can go into the field. If you do not have a forklift, other delivery arrangements can be made.
- Depending on the size of the order, we can either wait for the bins to be emptied or make arrangements to pick them up at a later date.
- To better facilitate your delivery, it is helpful to provide us with a phone number, preferably cellular, for your field supervisor. Our drivers have cell phones, and may need to contact them for additional directions or with other questions during your delivery.
- Newly planted citrus trees require water immediately after being planted. We recommend you have your irrigation system in place and operating or that watering arrangements have been made prior to your delivery.
